This month's featured idea was designed by Madalyn Van Cooney, Firelands Class of 2021.


Madalyn's design includes an outline of Ohio with Firelands Falcons in the middle of the design. Our school logo, the Falcon, is located at the top center.



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# TERMINOLOGY 101






# SNEAK PEEK
